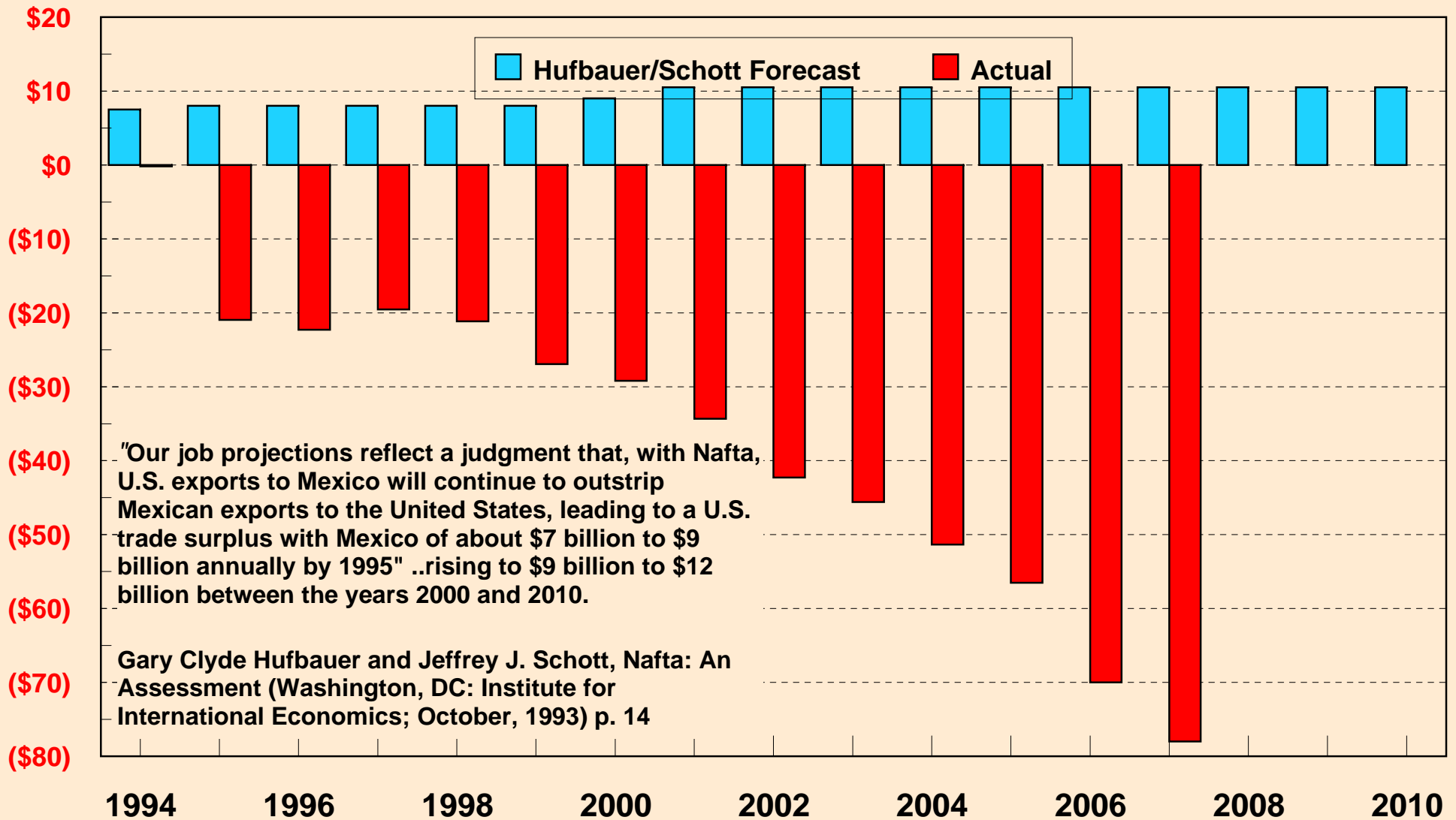

Billions of Dollars: U.S. Annual Current Accounts Balance With Mexico



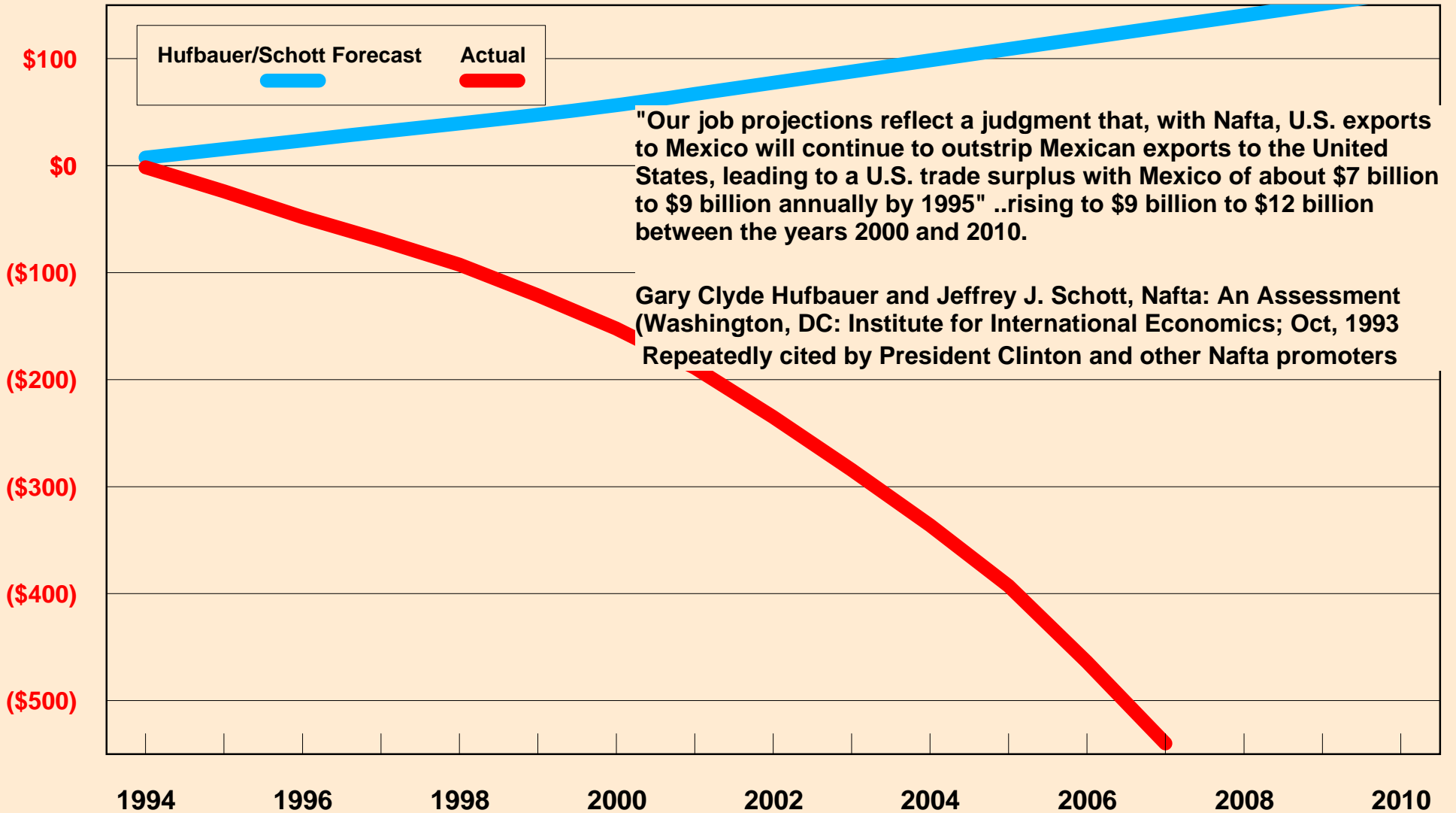
